A Note From Your Safety Committee

We have recently revised some of our range rules and have made new signs. Along with this newsletter is a copy of the revised rules. Please take time to read them, and save them for future reference. We will begin replacing the signs shortly after mailing this newsletter. The new rules will be enforced as soon as the signs are changed, but until that time, please continue to adhere to the old rules.

The new target frame posts on the 25 Foot Range (Combat range) did not last a week before someone shot holes in them. Remember if we catch anyone destroying club property, we will immediately terminate your membership, no questions asked! This club belongs to the members, so please enjoy, take care of it and report any problems to any Board Member (Phone numbers are on the front page)

Shoot straight, and often

KFGA General Rules

These rules are applicable to ALL KFGA facilities

1. All shooters must sign in and out on each range, specifying membership number, time in time out, gun caliber, and names of guests if any.
2. Your membership card must be visible at all times
3. Shooting hours are 10 AM (except scheduled events) to sunset (sunset time is posted on each range)
4. Members are responsible for actions of their guests. A maximum of two guests is permitted
5. Do not handle weapons behind firing line. Weapons shall be unloaded, with actions open until on the line. Concealed carry weapons must be unloaded while on club property.
6. Do not handle weapons when people are down range.
7. Report infractions of these and any other rules to any board member.
8. Infractions may result in suspension or revocation of membership privileges.
9. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited on KFGA property.
10. Clean up your trash before leaving the range.
11. Ear and Eye protection is required on all shooting ranges.

Trap Range

1. Clay birds only.
2. 12 gauge or smaller shotguns only.
3. 7 1/2 or 8 shot low brass only.
4. Two rounds in gun maximum
5. One shooter on the line at a time.
6. No hand throwers; use the club provided machine.

25/50 Yard Pistol Range

1. Handguns only on this range.
2. Muzzle shall be kept below the backstop at all times.
3. Post only one target per station.
4. Do not hang targets on upright or horizontal supports. Use paper targets only.
5. Weapons shall be loaded with a maximum of six rounds

100 Yard Rifle Range

1. Rifles only, with exception of pistol permit holders.
2. Shotguns with slugs may be fired at the far right homasote.
3. Five rounds maximum in magazine.
4. No mid range targets.
5. Do not hang targets on upright or horizontal supports. Use paper targets only.

50 Yard Range

1. .17 and .22 rimfire rifles, black powder rifles, and rifles in pistol caliber only.
2. Shotguns may be fired at the far right hand homasote only.
3. Five rounds maximum in magazine.
4. Paper targets only.
5. No mid range targets.
6. Do not hang targets on upright or horizontal supports.

25 Foot Range

1. Paper or cardboard targets only; Bowling pin by permit only.
2. Shooters shall stand at not more than 25 feet from target.
3. Full metal jacket ammunition is prohibited for use on bowling pins.
4. Do not hang targets on vertical or horizontal supports, or on pin tables.

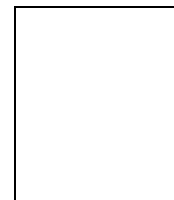
Archery Range

1. Field points only.
2. NO broadheads.
3. No shooting when someone is down range.
4. No handguns, shotguns, or rifles.
5. Do not hang targets on wood.
6. Practice range safety at all times.
7. Clean up trash before leaving.
8. Stay on club property.

These rules have been made for your safety and to protect our facility.
Please obey all rules and report infractions. Remember this club belongs
to you and the rest of the members.
